RE : Arrangements for September 2021

I am writing to outline the start to the new academic year for your child.

As you will be aware, we were unable to have the transition day we would have liked and therefore, a decision has been made by the school to do this in September.

On Monday 6th September, Exhall Grange will open specifically for Year 7 to complete a transition day. This means they will have time with their new form tutors, experience a range of subjects and meet with their new peers.

I have attached a copy of the timetable for this day. The pupils will not need any specific equipment for the lessons, but in Secondary we encourage the pupils to have their own pens, pencils, colours etc in a pencil case.

Prior to our opening on Monday, we would like to offer the opportunity for your child to have a Lateral Flow Test (LFT) in school to ensure they do not have COVID at the beginning of the new school term.

School will be open on Friday 3rd September from 1:30pm until 3:30pm if you feel you would like to do this. It is not necessary to make an appointment but we would ask that you bring your completed consent form with you.
