Dear Parents/Carers,

Coronavirus Update

I hope that you are safe and well. Unfortunately since we have returned to school after the summer break we are experiencing rising positive cases. Some of you will have already received a letter/letters to inform you of any positive cases within your child's class/year group/taxi.

I wanted to take this opportunity to urge you to regularly test (LFT) your child (including primary children where possible) at least twice per week. We are seeing a number of asymptomatic cases.

If the test is positive, please book a confirmatory PCR test immediately and keep your child at home until the result is received. If the result is negative and your child is well, then they can come to school.

If the result is positive, please inform the school immediately on 07825 230940 preferably by text giving your child's name, when the symptoms started or the date of the PCR test.

I am requesting that all secondary aged pupils now wear face coverings indoors if they are able to.

No visitors will be allowed on site unless absolutely necessary, e.g. therapeutic professionals, health carers.

Should cases continue to rise, the next precautionary steps will be to move back to bubble systems.
