

## HOMEWORK Policy and Timetables 2021-22

### Primary

All pupils have reading books that are sent home on a daily basis.

Pupils in Key Stages 1 and 2 have access to the primary library. Pupils are encouraged to borrow books which correspond to their level in Accelerated Reader.

Tier 1 and 2 words are sent home for spelling practice and in Upper Key Stage 2 (years 5 and 6 ) homework is sent home weekly and the subject may vary.

### Key Stage 3 (Years 7, 8, 9)

At Key Stage 3 it is advised that pupils complete two pieces of home work each day and similar over the weekend in the core subjects of English, Maths and Science. Homework should not take any longer than 20 minutes per subject.
