| <p>Improve the pupils literacy levels</p> <p>Part of the role of the new school Librarian is to work alongside the English Lead to have a renewed focus on reading through a variety of initiatives. The library will be an environment that is conducive to positive outcomes.</p> <p>The English Lead to attend a Literacy Course, Creating Champions for Literacy Difficulties. This course aims to improve whole school literacy strategy, create a more inclusive culture and greater outcomes for pupils.</p> <p>Invest in a Literacy Program, Lexonik, to improve pupils reading, spelling, vocabulary and comprehension. | <p>Improve the pupils English GCSE Grades</p> <p>AQA Exampro subscription for English.
