Be respectful to staff and other pupils/students and understand that everyone has the right to learn.	Be respectful to pupils/students and staff and be informed about pupils/students needs.
Follow the school policy of no mobile phones.	Only use a mobile phone in the presence of pupils/students if it is a work mobile and related to work.
Recognise that tasks are not always easy, and work will be challenging but ensure you always try your best.	Recognise that work will be challenging but ensure you always give your best, building and modelling resilience.
Understand that all actions have consequences both positive and negative.	Address both positive and negative behaviours fairly and according to pupil need.
Communicate your needs, likes and dislikes politely and with respect.	Communicate politely and with respect to all pupils/students and staff.
Be prepared to give things another go, even after you feel that things have gone wrong.	Be prepared to restore and rebuild a relationship with pupils/students or staff so that you can move on positively.
